Quantitative Highlights

- Before (Book Club programming) – **25%** of the students listed reading as a favorite subject. After Book Club sessions **44%** of students reported reading as a favorite subject.
- Before (Book Club programming) – **42%** of students reported having more than **20** books at home. After Book Club programming, **76%** of students reported having more than **20** books at home.
- Before (Book Club programming) – **14%** of the students reported having great grades. After (Book Club programming) **50%** of the students reported having great grades.
- Thirty-Six (**36%**) percent of students reported an increase in visits to the public library.
- Eighty-four (**84%**) percent of all students reported they wanted this type of programming again the next year.
- Sixty-four (**64%**) percent reported they read for fun everyday after participating in Book Club programming.
