



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
Between Starling K-8 and Youth for Christ's City Life Center

Youth for Christ's City Life Center is applying for the State of Ohio Community Connectors grant. The Community Connectors program is designed to *"bring together students, their families, schools, communities, faith-based groups, and businesses in mentoring programs."*

To work together to positively impact the middle school students of Franklinton, City Life is asking Starling K-8 for assistance with the following...

- The identification and recruitment of 24 middle school students to take part in City Life's Mentoring Program associated with the Community Connectors program.
- Facilitating informal quarterly meetings between Mentors/City Life staff and mentee's teachers.
- Appropriate communication regarding mentees behavioral and academic progress, in fulfillment of grant's request that partners *"have appropriate access to data for purposes of grant program improvement and evaluation in accordance with state and federal law"*.
- Allowance/Scheduling of both middle and high school mentees participating in Columbus Tutoring Initiative as 'Reading Buddies' with elementary student at Starling K-8.

Furthermore, City Life and Starling Middle school affirm that this is an 'at will' agreement, and that NO MONETARY COSTS/REIMBURSEMENTS are involved in the partnership/agreement.

The parties, Starling K-8 and The City Life Center, indicate agreement with this MOU by their signatures.
