**DESCRIPTION OF NATURE OF PARTNERSHIP FOR PAX Good Behavior Game**


This partnership is an association between Wright State University as applicant for Straight A Funding and PAXIS Institute as primary partner and other community-based partners throughout Ohio to deliver and promote gold-standard, scientifically proven strategy called, PAX GBG, to advance immediate and lifetime indicators of sustainable academic and behavioral outcomes for 1200 first-grade classrooms, their teachers, and approximately 30,000 first graders.

As applicant, Wright State University agrees to be responsible for ensuring that this grant is developed and executed according to the terms of the grant agreement with the Straight A Program Governing Board, including coordinating recruitment, training events, and impact monitoring of PAX GBG. PAXIS Institute agrees to be responsible for providing the copyrighted materials, accredited training and other related supports for the targeted 500 first-grade classrooms targeted for using PAX GBG. Other parties to this partnership agree to recruit classrooms and promote PAX GBG during and after this funding award for sustainable change in classrooms, students, and communities.

Each member of the partnership is responsible for the following assurances:

1. Be knowledgeable about the applicant's Straight A Fund grant proposal and application, including advocacy of the Straight A Fund program.
2. Maintain familiarity with the partner's services to enhance the proposal, including specific goals and practices of PAX GBG.
3. Demonstrate a commitment to clear roles and responsibilities of each partner as it relates to the grant proposal and application.
4. Sustain consistent communication among partners and stakeholders with a shared vision of the goals of the grant proposal. This includes participating in regularly scheduled meetings for project management and identifying areas for improvement.
5. Ensure partners have appropriate access to data for purposes of grant program improvement and evaluation in accordance with state and federal law.
6. Develop a clear project management plan to sustain the project over time.
