**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF YOUNGSTOWN CITY SCHOOLS PARTICIPATION
IN THE YOUNGSTOWN STRAIGHT A PROPOSAL I REGARDING “FUNDING AN
EXPERT REVIEW OF THE BUSINESS OFFICE, TREASURER’S OFFICE AND THE
HUMAN RESOURCE DEPARTMENT, IN ORDER TO DETERMINE WAYS TO GAIN
EFFICIENCY.”**

WHEREAS, in order to assist the Youngstown City School District (the “District”) to improve the District’s academic performance and pursuant to R.C. 3302.10 the Superintendent of Public Instruction established the Academic Distress Commission for the Youngstown City School District (the “Commission”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 3302.10 the Commission has adopted and updated an Academic Recovery Plan (the “ARP”) for the District and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction has approved such Commission actions; and

WHEREAS, the Youngstown Superintendent contacted the Chair of the Youngstown Academic Distress Commission requesting a resolution of support, as required by the proposal application question 7 (<http://education.ohio.gov/Topics/Straight-A-Fund/Application-Materials>), from the Academic Distress Commission for the District’s participation in a Straight A Fund proposals; and

WHEREAS, the proposal is described as “an expert review of the business office treasurer’s office and human resource department, in order to determine ways to gain efficiency.” ; and

WHEREAS, this proposal is not in conflict with the Ohio Department of Education approved plans for academic improvement in the Youngstown City Schools; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Youngstown Academic Distress Commission hereby supports Youngstown’s participation in this proposal.

WHEREFORE, the foregoing Resolution was moved by Michael Garvey, seconded by Dr. Paul Williams, and duly adopted on October 17, 2013, upon roll call further resulting in four yeas and none nays.
