

Goals

- 100% of HAA students will have success plans based on OhioMeansJobs backpack
- 90% of HAA students who request or are recommended for apprenticeships, internships, and/or credential training receive placement
- Reduce all HAA and HTHS credit recovery needs 75% by 2020
- Increase CC+ students from 6 to 50 by 2017-18, to 300 by the end of 2020-21
- Involve and engage students; reduce discipline referrals by 25%
- Raise the community median income beyond expected standard of living increase over the next ten years
- Give community residents priority scheduling for local Columbus State classes and host career fairs and training for community residents
